ABOUT SHREE RAMNATH DEVASTHAN

Shree Ramnath Devasthan is one of the prestigious Devasthans of the State of Goa or Gomantak, known to be the Devabhumi. The Ponda Taluka or Antruz Mahal is the seat of many of the famous Devasthans and Temples including Shree Ramnath Devasthan situated in a serene and scenic village of Ramnathi, Bandivade. Shree Ramnath Devasthan holds great significance not only in the State of Goa but also across India and overseas. The Mahajans and Kulavees of this Devasthan belong either to Koundindya or Vatsa Gotra. Due to the atrocities inflicted by the foreign invaders, the Devotees of this Devasthan had to take shelter in the neighbouring states and settle there to earn their living. However, they have strong affinity towards their Kuldevata and come regularly to Ramnathi and pay their respect and seek Divine blessings. Many devotees visit the temple during the festivals and otherwise. Devotees especially from outside Goa choose to stay in the temple premises and find solace and blessings.

The regular rituals like Abhisheks, Poojas, Shibikotsavas, Anusththanas, etc. for the Deities are performed holistically and Mahajans and Kulavees attend enthusiastically in large numbers and seek Divine Blessings. At Shree Ramnath Devasthan many Utsavas like Navatratri, Mahashivaratri, Palkhi Utsavas, Ashwin Shuddha Dashmi (Dusshera), Ashwin Shuddha Ekadashi Annual Kaul Prasad, Tulasi Vivah and Kalotsav draw large attendance from its devotees across the State of Goa and the neighbouring states.

This Devasthan is a master piece of beautifully sculptured design and extraordinary architecture. Hence this serene and mystic place gives an enlightening and a satisfying feeling when one visits this temple.





INFRASTRUCTURE

A Journey So Far...

The Devasthan's agrashalla had about 80 rooms which were planned and designed as per the standards of the relevant time. In addition, there are 3 large halls and small meeting places having altogether a capacity of about 2000 pax. within the Devasthan Complex. Most of these facilities are generally occupied for conferences, weddings, thread ceremonies and other religious functions.

Majority of the above infrastructure is quite old and is below the currently acceptable standards. Devasthan Managing Committees have done their best to upkeep these facilities with periodic repairs and refurbishment. With ageing of the infrastructure the upkeep and improvement is a challenge. Besides this, there are limitations as well as challenges to improve or upgrade these facilities considering the overall layout of the campus, ageing of the structures and cost involved.

The Devasthan with the approval of Mazania has taken a complete review of the development needs and has taken a decision to modernize and upgrade the Devasthan's infrastructure and bring about an overall Devasthan's Prakar Jirnoddar. With the Blessings of Shree Laxminarayan Ramnath Panchist Devata and Param Pujya Shreemad Vidyadheesh Teerth Shreepad Vader Swami Maharaj. The Devasthan Committee commenced the development of the Devasthan's Infrastructure in a phased manner.

Phase-I was completed in a record time of 17 months with all statutory compliances and inaugurated at the holy hands of Param Pujya Shreemad Vidyadheesh Teerth Shreepad Vader Swami Maharaj in January 2025.

PHASE I FACILITIES

The Phase-I was planned in a need based manner and comprises of the following facilities:

PHASE I – BLOCK A

SHREE INDIRAKANT BHAVAN.

Shree Swamiji's Niwas-sthan, Pooja Room, Ashirvad Hall and 11 spacious 4 bedded AC rooms with attached toilet and state of the art facilities.

SHREE SIDDHINATH RATH GRAHA

A long aspired secure place to house all the Rathas / Vahanas / Sukhasan / Palkhis.

VASTRA BHANDAR

The various items like Sarees, Uparnes, Pitambers, Blouse pieces (Khanas), etc. piously offered at the Lotus Feet of the respective Deities are stored & displayed in an orderly manner and auctioned at discounted prices to devotees who opt to possess the prized Holy items.

A ROOM FOR NATYAMANDAL & EXTENDED OFFICE

To hold meetings, count the Fund Peti Receipts etc.

A LINEN ROOM

To store the linen and housekeeping materials.



PHASE I – BLOCK B

SHREE RAMNATH NIWASI SANKUL (SRNS)


A ground plus two storeyed building constructed to house 30 spacious 2 bedded AC Rooms with attached toilet and state of the art facilities.

The development plan (Phase-I) provide better modern facilities to Mahajans and Kulavis during their visits at Devasthan. Besides this, the development plan also include measures to mitigate the safety challenges to the infrastructure of yesteryears.

The Phase-I facilities were well received by the visiting devotees with encouraging feedback and inputs that helped us to fine tune the services to the satisfaction of the visiting devotees. Taking into consideration the faith reposed in us by the visiting devotees, the Devasthan Committee feels duty-bound to provide better services to the devotees so as to make them feel at home whilst focussing all their time and energy in the prayers and sevas at the Lotus Feet of the Deities to seek the Blessings. In view of this, the Devasthan Committee constantly upgrades its execution of the various services like ease of booking the rooms, booking Sevas & Shashwat Sevas by both Online and On-site approach, upgraded Canteen facilities etc. so as to make the stay in the Divine ambience of the Devotees pleasant and holy.

(Ground Floor - Annadaan / Dining Hall). Capacity - 200 pax



SHREE RAMNATH SABHAGRAHA
(Ground Floor - Wedding Hall & Mahashivratri / Navratri Annasantarpan Hall)
Capacity - 750 pax



SHREE SHANTERI NIWASI SADAN – (SSNS)

(Upper Ground Floor – Above Shree Laxminarayan Sabhagraha) 10 spacious 4 bedded AC family rooms with attached toilet and state of the art facilities.



SHREE VIDYADHIRAJ SABHAGRAHA

(First Floor - Wedding Hall) Capacity - 1000 pax.



SHREE BETAL SABHAGRAHA

(First Floor - Dining Hall) Capacity 280 pax



DEVASTHAN KITCHEN

Centralised Kitchen with storage facility and modern kitchen equipment with due regard to hygiene.

SHREE NARCINV PURUSH CONFERENCE HALL

(First Floor - Meeting Room) Capacity 50 pax

DEVASTHAN NAIVEDYA GRAHA

Shree Laxminarayan Ramnath Panchista Holy Naivedya Kitchen

MULTILEVEL PARKING

Place is identified behind Block C to accommodate multilevel parking facility.

PHASE- II BLOCK D

SHREE KAMAXI NIWASI SADAN (SKNS)

Houses a total of 54 AC rooms with 48 spacious 2 bedded & 6 four bedded rooms with state of the art facilities.
